

I was first elected in a bye-election in September 2000 and have been re-elected three times since then, serving as Vice Chairman on several occasions.

I have represented the Ratepayers/ Electorate on various matters, including the Richmond Hill Committee, Municipal Association and have been pleased to assist parishioners on various matters, including planning problems and housing matters.

Although the last few years have been very trying and difficult, I believe the Board has come through it stronger and are even more committed to serving the best interests of the parishioners.

The unfortunate dismissal of the former Clerk in 2007 was unavoidable, on the grounds of serious misconduct, however, because the matter is still ongoing by way of protracted litigation and is sub judice, we are unable to discuss or disclose the details.

- Development of community car parks at Union Mills and Port Soderick and safer pedestrian protection throughout.
- Development of facilities for the youth (playground) Ballanawin, Cronk Grianagh Park.
